

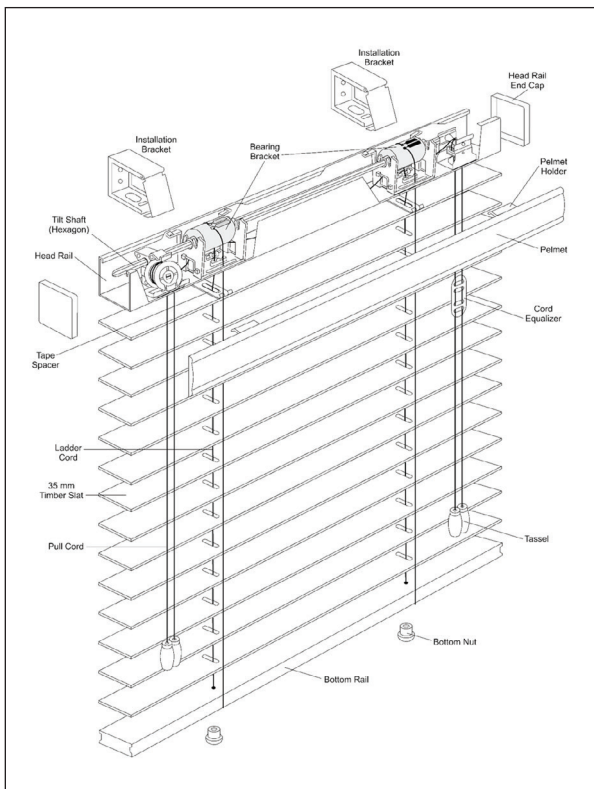

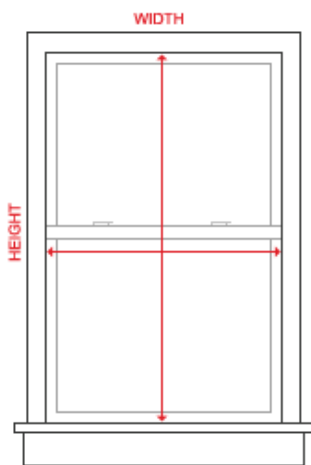
TIMBER BLINDS

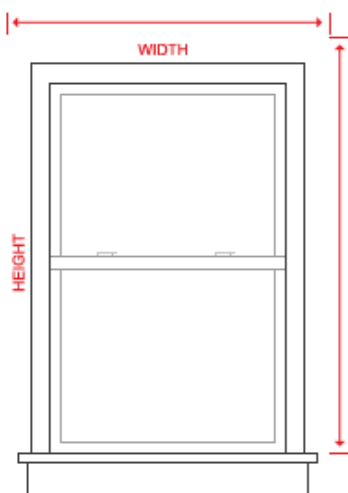

THE MEASUREMENT



HOW TO MEASURE INSIDE MOUNT

1. Measure the width inside the window opening at the top, middle and bottom. Take the narrowest of the three width measurements, and round down to the nearest 1/8".
2. Measure the height inside the window opening from the top of the window opening to the window sill three times. Measure once on the left, at the center, and on the right and take the longest of the three measurements. If you prefer to keep the blind from resting on the sill deduct a 1/4" from the height. If your window does not have a sill, measure to the point you would like the blind to reach.
3. Measure the window on the diagonal. If the two diagonal dimensions differ significantly, it may be necessary to order an outside mount for optimal light control and privacy. See measuring instructions below.
4. Do not take any allowances on the height or width. The factory will take all required allowances on an inside mount for mounting and operating clearance.



HOW TO MEASURE INSIDE MOUNT

1. Measure the width inside the window opening at the top, middle and bottom. Take the narrowest of the three width measurements, and round down to the nearest 1/8".
2. Measure the height inside the window opening from the top of the window opening to the window sill three times. Finally choose tilt cord for your blinds.

String is used to open and close wooden blinds. As a result, it's critical to make sure you select the appropriate string when selecting your window covering.

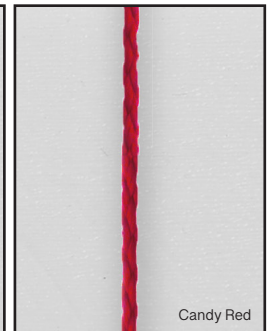
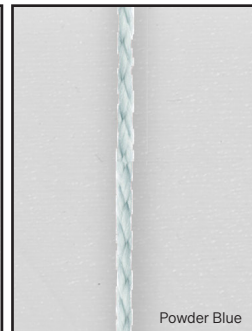
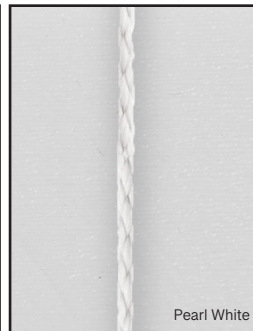
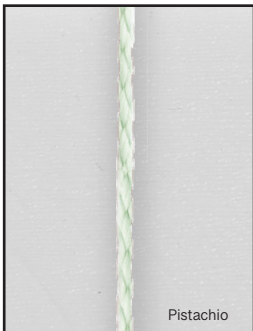
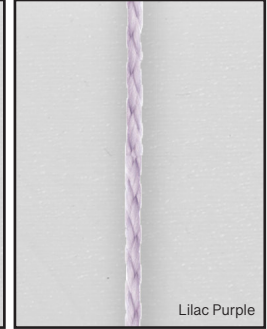
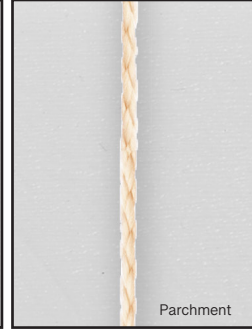
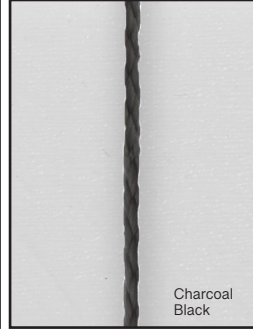
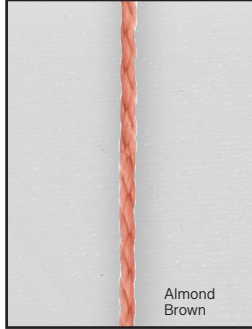
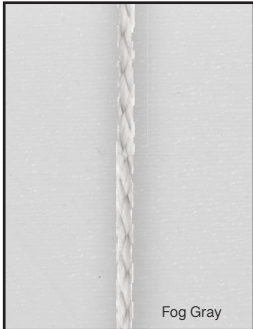
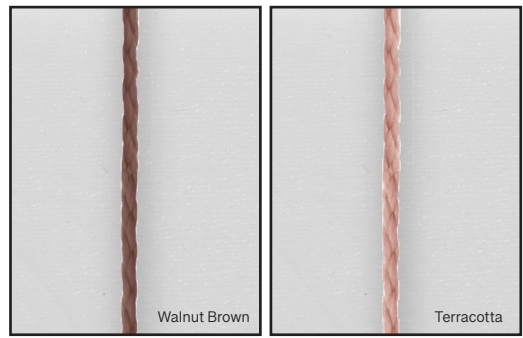

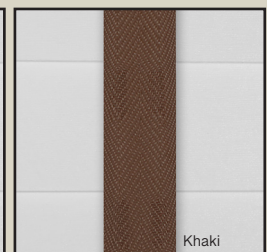
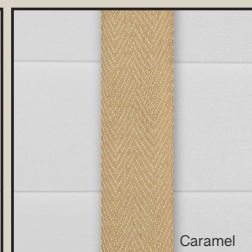
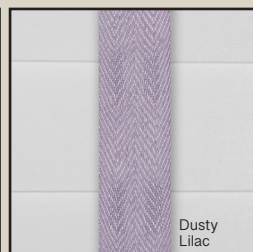
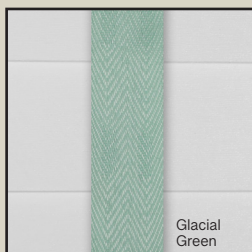
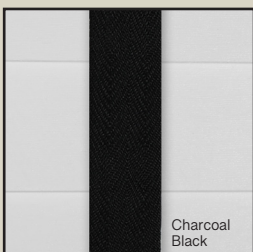
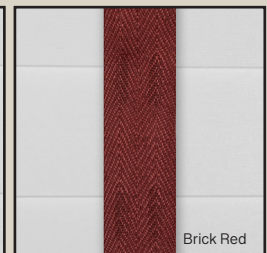
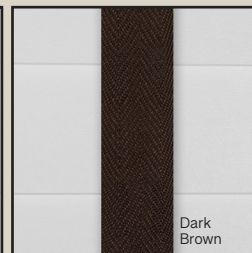
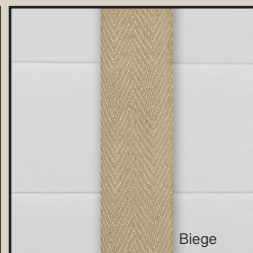
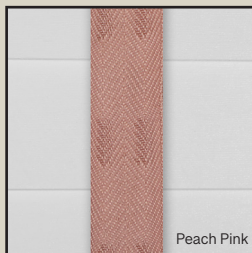
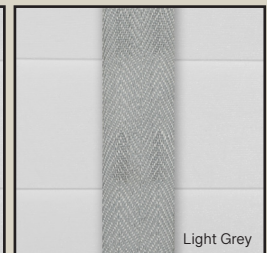
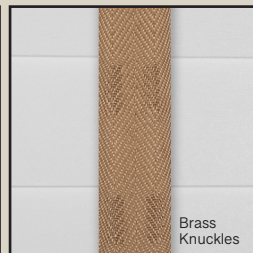
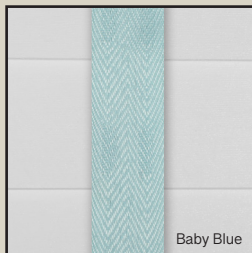
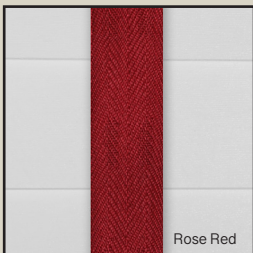
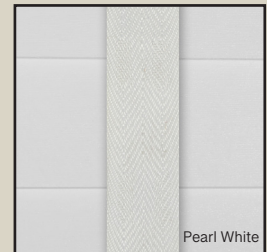
Two external strings holding a horizontal blind in place. The bottom rail of the braided ladder is where it ends after passing through the middle of the slats and being attached at the headrail. Decorative tapes can frequently be used to cover these.

DECORATIVE TAPE

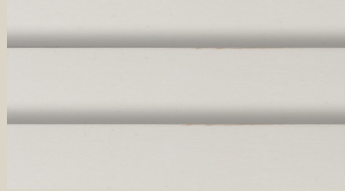
Wooden blind decorative tapes, sometimes referred to as "ladder tapes" are vertical fabric strips that pass between the slats of your wooden blind from top to bottom. By holding the slats in place, these tapes support the structure and maintain the slats' symmetry and order.

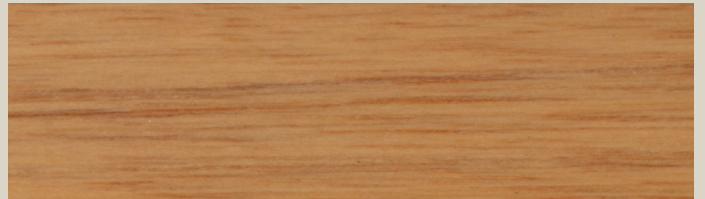
ROSEWOOD

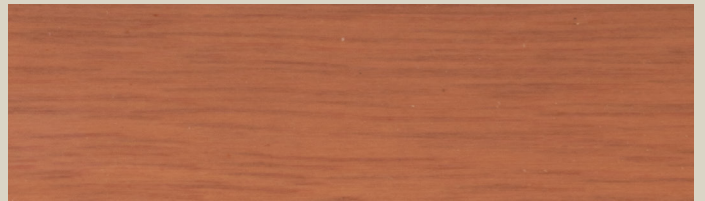
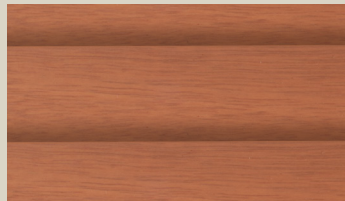
NATURAL

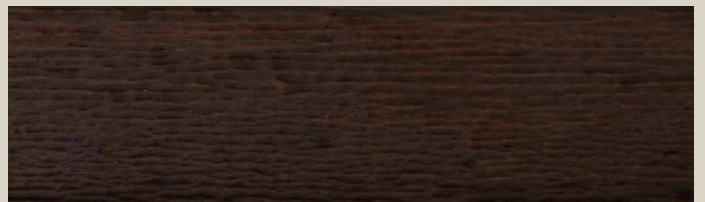
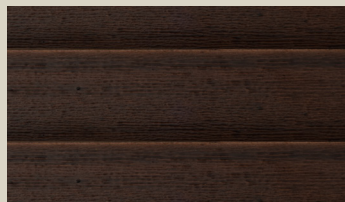
GOLDEN OAK

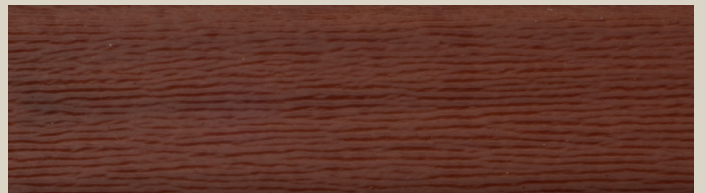
TEAK
